SESSION ACTIONS DURING THE MONTH OF APRIL ...

 Your Session met virtually a couple of times during April and here are the actions they took:
*A secret ballot second vote was approved on a request for \$37,565 from the Property Committee for Phase 1 of the mortar replacement project to be conducted by Waters Craftsman Inc.. Phase #1 will consist of the work on the Sycamore St. side of the White Chapel. The funds would come from the Earle Fund.

*Voted to approve the following proxy items related to our Citizens Bank Stock holdings. First - To fix the maximum number of Directors of the Citizens Financial Corp. at nine. Second - To elect the following directors at Citizens Bank Corp. in the class of 2023 – William T. Johnson Jr., Robert L. Morris Jr., and Franklin M. Santmyer, Jr.

*Voted to worship by Radio and Facebook only until further notice.

- *Voted to receive Carson Michael Crawford into the membership of DMPC. Carson is a senior at D&E graduating this Spring.
- *To reimburse Bob McCutcheon up to \$1,500 for travel expenses incurred on his recent trip to Kenya. The funds would come from the Missionary Fund. This request was presented by Bob to the WS Committee prior to the trip but was never acted upon, thus its reimbursement form. This is a first vote of two.
