SESSION NOTES FROM NOVEMBER 8, 2020...

At its November 8, 2020 meeting the following actions were taken by the Session:

- *Transferred the membership of Carson Crawford to the Moorefield Presbyterian Church.
- *Dana Marzolf reported that the Christmas Eve Service this year will be broadcast on WDNE 1240AM radio station as well as streamed live on Facebook.
- *Heard a report from Bob McCutcheon on giving opportunities in Kenya and ways the congregation could be involved going forward.
- *Considered a recommendation from Steve Cook that "law and order" be listed in the weekly prayer list in the bulletin. The Session decided to list "Peace and Civility in our communities and country" instead.
- *With the difficulty in nominating and electing a new class of elders this year it was decided to keep all session members in place and move their term forward by one year and to request a temporary waiver from the Presbytery for this year.
- *With the pandemic spreading it was decided that virtual worship continue into the coming months.
- *Peter Vial was granted vacation time December 26th through December 29th.
- *Robert Hermanson was approved for fill the pulpit to preach on December 27th.
- *Dana Marzolf was elected as commissioner to the next Presbytery meeting November 19th.

DECEMBER 24TH @7PM


