## SESSION NOTES FOR MAY 2021...

At its May 10<sup>th</sup> stated meeting the Session took the following actions and discussed the following issues:

- \*The meeting was opened with a devotional and prayer by Kim White
- \*The Clerk noted the death of Randy Kyle on April 17<sup>th</sup>
- \*Voted in the affirmative on the second vote on sending \$8500 to the Ons Plek Project in South Africa where Melody Meadows has been our lead missionary.

  This was from the Missionary Fund.
- \*Voted in the affirmative on a first vote to use \$400 from the Angel Fund to cover wiring fees, our membership contribution to the PCUSA Kenya Mission Network, and conference registration for Bob McCutcheon's participation.
- \*Noted that July 10<sup>th</sup> is the next Common Ground Café that we will host at Woodford United Methodist Church. We need volunteers and donations. Sue Chenoweth is heading up this event.
- \*Planned for a July 18<sup>th</sup> picnic and vesper service in the city park.
- \*Voted to allow a July 31<sup>st</sup> wedding in the Sanctuary and to allow memorial services to gather in the Sanctuary as part of our "soft opening" as we head for in person worship in September.
- \*Heard a recommendation from the Worship committee that we continue to aim toward September 12<sup>th</sup> as our opening day for in person worship.
- \*Heard a report from the Membership Committee that they are staying in touch with homebound members.
- \*Heard from the Property committee about the continuing work on the mortar replacement on the outside walls on the north side of the church and plans to repair plaster work in the White Chapel where water damage has occurred. Also heard plans to engage the services of Cintas for our cleaning supplies, including hand sanitizing stations.
- \*Elected Dana Marzolf as our commissioner to Presbytery meeting on May 20<sup>th</sup>.
- \*Celebrated with the Chenoweth family on Levi Fath's new job in geology in Idaho. Prayed for the congregation during this time of pandemic.


