# SESSION NOTES FROM THE FEBRUARY 13<sup>TH</sup> STATED MEETING OF SESSION...

Actions taken included:

- \*The second, secret-ballot vote was taken to approve the request from Worship Committee to transfer up to \$125,000 from the Gordon and Betty Barrick Charitable Trust Fund as an "anchor gift" to a matching-fund capital campaign dedicated to restoring and stabilizing the bell tower.
- \*Second, secret-ballot vote, the Session approved Elder McCutcheon's request to transfer \$27,000 from the Missionary Fund for the remaining balance of the original request for travel expenses, fees and project gifts for his extended mission trip to Kenya.
- \*Elder McCutcheon has made a request for \$2,295.00 from the Missionary Fund for a Travel Study Seminar with Presbyterian Native Americans in the Southwestern United States. Upon motion, second and discussion, Session approved the requested amount of \$2,295.00 be transferred from the Angel Fund for the seminar registration fee and associated costs as itemized.
- \*Mr. Marstiller brought the committee's baseline spending recommendation of 2.5% for approval. After discussion, the recommendation was approved on voice vote.
- \*Clerk of Session Lynn Proudfoot was elected commissioner for the February 16<sup>th</sup> Presbytery meeting on Zoom.
- \*Bread and Broth study series will be held the five Wednesdays in March at 6:00pm at HTLC. See bulletin for more details.
- \*Session elected an Interim Pastor Nominating Committee who will begin a search for an interim pastor soon. Members of the committee elected are Jean Snedegar, Cliff Marstiller, Hillary Shryock, Phil Becker, Kim White and from HTLC, Greg Schumacher and Ric Campbell. The first meeting of the committee will be March 7<sup>th</sup> at 6:00pm when Ed Thompson, General Presbyter from the Presbytery, will orient the committee and train them for their work.
- \*Peter Vial will be taking some days off to move out of the Manse into a home which he and Tina have bought. Moving week is March 10 and 11.
- \*The next Common Ground Café which we are hosting will be May 6<sup>th</sup> at Woodford UMC.
