At its March 11th meeting, Session attended to the following items:

- * Elder Tessa Garver-Daniels presented devotional contemplations on the influence of senior church members on newer and younger members. She shared "The Coming of the Lord" passage from Thessalonians 4:13-18, then a prayer.
- * Approved Minutes from the February 12, 2024, meeting, which are posted on the bulletin board in the hallway or available upon request from the clerk. The 2023 Statistical Report to the General Assembly is posted on the bulletin board in the hallway or available by request from the clerk.
- * Treasurer Treasurer Marstiller reported Elder Lynn Proudfoot is assisting with the March Weekly Counting Reports. Elder Debra Everhart volunteered to assist during April.
- * Finance Voted to procure a \$1,000 daily limited debit card for the pastor. Accepted financial reports. Reports are available from the treasurer upon request.
- * Property Perfection Plus will sanitize the flood area soon and we are seeking bids for restoration. The elevator inspection and certification process is underway. We are exploring options to change the HVAC controls and service contracts. Our upgraded hardwire internet connection is scheduled for installation. The Sycamore entry system and doors are scheduled for replacement, weather permitting. Due to termite damage, we are seeking bids for razing the Manse 2 garage.
- * Worship Approved WVU Lutheran Campus Ministry Chaplain Rev. Benjamin Erzkus to preach on July 14th.
- * Witness and Service The next Common Ground meal is May 11th.
- * Christian Education The Confirmation Class is underway.
 The Easter Egg Hunt is planned for Palm Sunday.
 Festival of Faith is at First Presbyterian, Charleston, on April 6th.
- * Membership We have the final draft of the pictorial directory.
- * Fellowship A coffee fellowship is planned for Palm Sunday.
- * Nominating/Leadership Development Elected Elder Mike Bell to serve as chairperson of the Stewardship Committee.
- * Approved the Annual Congregational Meeting following worship on Sunday, April 14, 2024.
